Non-Sale Animal Fund Policy

The purpose of this fund is to provide exhibitors of the Fort Bend County Fair with financial assistance towards a new project or future education. Any amount paid to an exhibitor will be determined by the amount in the fund.

The following will apply to all exhibitors making application for financial assistance.

1. **Deadline for applications is Monday, October 22, 2018. An application for financial assistance must be completely filled out, signed and received by the deadline date.**
2. The Fort Bend Buyers Group does not take the meat and is not responsible for the processing. Processing costs for the animals are the responsibility of the student.
3. To be eligible final disposition of the animal needs to be terminal or for breeding purposes.
4. The student is asked to provide the disposition of the animal – the application signed is the only proof required. If this disposition is not provided, we will not process the application until this information is received.
5. Students must provide a signature from their Ag. Teacher or advisor as evidence of the animal(s) raised. All signatures (Students, Parents, and Teacher/Advisor) are required.
6. Animals sold in the Premium or Freezer Sale are not eligible.
7. The amount each student will receive will be determined after all applications are received and evaluated.
8. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to return the application to the address on the application with appropriate signatures by the deadline.
9. If an exhibitor raised multiple projects, please list all projects with the disposition of each and any money received for each.
10. If all animals were non-sale, then only one project will be eligible for financial assistance.
11. Payment will be made directly to the student.
12. Decisions of the Fort Bend Buyers Group Non-Sale Committee are final.
